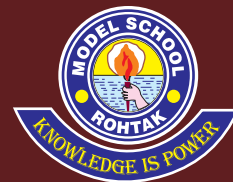

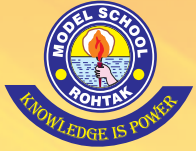

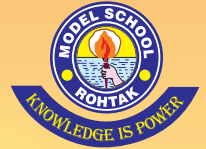

Padma Vibhushan Sh. Hari Dev Shourie, our founder chairman, was born in Lahore in undivided India in 1911. In 1952, he was the Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak. Only a few years back, India had been partitioned and there had been a mass movement of population. Rohtak had received its share of immigrants from across the border and families uprooted needed new roots, new bearings and new visions. The most important issue, which was uppermost in the minds of all, was good schooling for their children. Under the dynamic leadership of Sh. H.D. Shourie, it was decided to start an English medium co-educational school on public school lines to cater for all round development of the children. The school was started with the spirit of self help with just one room and it was named Junior Model School. The children of Mr. Arun Shourie is one of India's best known journalist and has been our former Union Minister for Communication, IT and Disinvestment. Sh. Deepak Shourie is Managing Director, Discovery Communication, India. His daughter, Nalini Singh is a renowned T.V. Journalist-Anchor-Managing Director, TV Live India Pvt. Ltd. Mr. Shourie himself was a well known consumer activist.

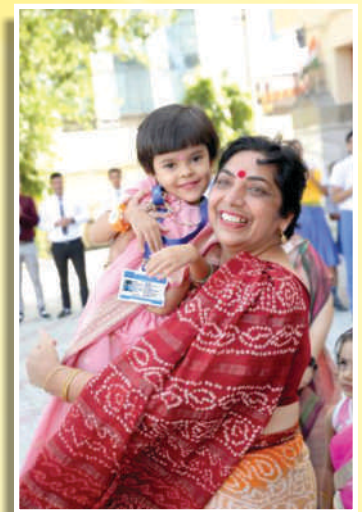

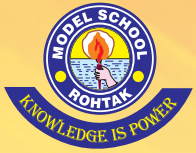


values that have defined our past academic, freedom, tolerance and experimentation.

ADMISSION POLICY

Admission to Classes Pre-nursery, Nursery and XI

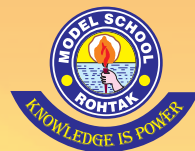
- ❖ Fresh admissions start in Pre-nursery, Nursery and XI classes only. Admission to other classes is subject to the availability of vacancies. Registration is a must for admission to any class. However registration does not guarantee admission.
- ❖ For admission to Pre-nursery age of the child should be 2 years onwards and for Nursery class age should be between 3 to 4 years as on 31 March that year. Registration for pre-nursery will start from the month of December and for Nursery is done in the month of January. Admission is granted on the first come first serve basis. At the time of admission, the original Date of Birth Certificate issued by the Municipal Committee and copy of Aadhar Card and Parivar Pehchan Patra ID (PPPI) is mandatory.
- ❖ Medical performa showing a true and detailed picture of the child's health should also be duly filled in and submitted at the time of admission. It is in the interest of the child as well as the school.
- ❖ Fee once paid will not be refunded in any case.
- ❖ Parents who wish to take T.C/School Leaving Certificate may apply on the Result Day i.e. in session end or before 10th April of that year. Students applying after 10th April will have to pay fee for the month of April. If TC is taken in the mid of the session that quarter fee has to be paid.
- ❖ Security deposited at the time of admission will be refunded only within one year of leaving the school. Kindly mention in whose name the security cheque is to be issue along with their bank account details to avoid dishonor of cheque. There will be no reissue of cheque on any pretext.

Admission in Class XI

Admission in Class XI will be carried out in two phases. Initially the students will be registered for admission by charging amount equivalent to three months fee. This amount will be adjusted against their fee while seeking permanent admission after declaration of X class board result. However this amount will stand forfeited for students who do not seek Re-admission under any circumstances. Regular classes (Bridge Course) will commence in the month of April tentatively.

Students from other schools

Students seeking admission from other schools affiliated to CBSE can be granted admission provided seats are available if they have minimum 75% in Science, Mathematics and overall. Students coming from Boards other than CBSE will generally not be granted admission in class XI. However extra ordinary meritorious students of English medium may be considered.



Allotment of streams

We have four streams in classes XI & XII i.e. Medical, Non Medical and Commence with and without Mathematics and Humanities.

Criteria for allotment of streams : **70% and above.**

Note :

1. At the time of registration marks of Pre-Board exam or where pre-Board is not conducted then marks of PT-1, PT-2 & Mid Term put together will be taken into account for allotment of streams. Students can take up stream of their choice only by giving an under taking until the X class final results. However, the CBSE latest policy will not be compromised on.
2. Change of stream/subject after registration with CBSE in class XI will not be permitted in any case.

Admission Procedure

Admission will be allowed only if there is vacancy for classes I to VIII. The student has to submit the TC of the previous school along with the original date of birth proof and Aadhar Card and ID. of Parivar Pehchan Patra.

For admission to classes IX a written test will be conducted in subjects Maths, Science and Social Science.

Meritorious students of other schools securing 90%-100% in class X can be admitted in class XI irrespective of this priority, category and strength of the class.

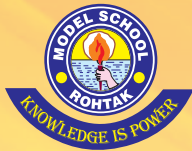
Outstanding sports persons who are position holders at State/National/International Level can be admitted if seats are available in a class.

Priority in admission will be given to transfer cases of Haryana/Central Government employees only.

However these will be within the laid down limits.

Admissions to classes X& XII will not be granted except for parents transfer cases, that too subject to availability of vacancies, approval by CBSE and Latest Govt Policy will be followed.

Number of seats will be restricted as per CBSE norms.



AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS / CONCESSIONS / GRANTS

1. Sports:

- a) Full fee concession for one year to International position holders except conveyance charges. In addition, scholarship of Rs. 2000 /- per month for entire period of stay in the school since the time of achievement, to the International position holders.
- b) CBSE /Haryana State Schools at National Level Tournaments position holders (recognised only)
 - I Position : Full Tuition fee concession for one year
 - II Position : 50% Tuition fee concession for one year
 - III Position : 25% Tuition fee concession for one year
- c) For National Participation/ State Level Position holder
(First Three Position) : **50% Tuition Fee concession. For 1 year.**

2. Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) :

As at serial 1(a), (b) and (c) above. CBSE recognised CCAs only are eligible.

- 3. **Academics** : The students of current session are eligible for prize at Annual Function, in addition to various prevailing schemes, the following awards will be given:

Class X & XII:

- ❖ Top three students securing 95% marks and above to get a gold plated, pure silver medal costing up to Rs 6500/- at the time of Annual Day.
- ❖ All subject as well as overall toppers with minimum 95% marks will be awarded Rs. 1100/- as incentive award at the time of Annual Day.

Class X & XI:

- ❖ Students securing 97% and above will be given 100% Tuition Fee concession.
- ❖ Students securing 93% and above but below 97% marks will be given 50% Tuition Fee concession.
- ❖ Students securing 90% and above but below 93% marks will be given 25% Tuition Fee concession.

- 4. **JEE (Advance)/Common Engineering Entrance Exam up to top 5000 ranks, AIIMS, NTSE (National Qualifiers) etc:-** Gold plated pure silver medal costing up to Rs. 6500/- at the time of Annual Day. Ranks will be counted for General Category only.

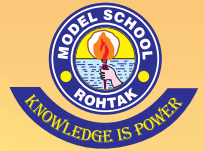
- 5. **NEET rank amongst First 1000, State PMT(Haryana) rank amongst first 100, CPT (CA) rank amongst first 100 and NDA as per the list approved by the Chairman from time to time:** Pure Silver Medal costing up to Rs. 6500/- at the time of Annual Day. Prior approval of the chairman will be a pre-requisite.

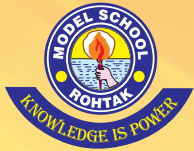
- 6. **Awards** : Award for excellence for the following will be intimated through circular from time to time.

- Scholar Badge : For excellence in academics - students scoring above 95% for continuous 3 years. (III to XII)
- Honours Badge : For excellence in sports/ Co- curricular activities and competitive exams.
